Alcohol Beverage And Drug Policy

Unilatina International College, in accordance with state laws, has adopted the following policy on alcohol and drugs consumption. UIC recognizes that the unlawful manufacture, sale, delivery, unauthorized possession or use of any illicit drug is prohibited on property owned or otherwise controlled by UIC. If an individual associated with the college is apprehended for violating any drug-or alcohol-related law when on college property, or participating in a college activity, UIC will fully cooperate with all law enforcement agencies. Underage possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted on property owned or controlled by the College and the state laws will be enforced. Intentionally or knowingly selling, or intentionally or knowingly furnishing alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21, or to persons obviously inebriated, is not permitted on property owned or controlled by the College. Any student caught under the influence of any such substance will be subject to penalties including dismissal from the College. A student may lost eligibility for any grant, loan, or work-study assistance as a result of penalties under 484(r)(1) of the HEA.
