

Transfer of Credits to UIC - (TC)

A student may be given credit hours after an evaluation of officially sealed transcripts are received directly from the other educational institution accredited by an agency recognized by the United States Department of Education.

Students who wish to register at UIC for a Bachelor degree must submit an official transcript showing an earned Associate degree. Credits will be evaluated course-by-course in order to assure that the applicant meets all course prerequisites.

Students who possess a degree abroad must provide UIC with an official evaluation of transcripts made by an International Credential Evaluator Institute. Additionally students must provide UIC detailed syllabi of the courses to be transferred. Student tuition's account will be adjusted to reflect the reduced hours of training.

UIC will only receive transfer credits for which grade is C or above. Transfer credits are not calculated in the CGPA. The maximum time frame (MTF) for a transfer student will be 1.5 times the total clock/quarter/semester credit hours needed for program completion.

There is a \$100.00 for evaluation. At least 50 percent of the clock/quarter/semester credit hours are required for completion of any program must be earned through UNILATINA INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE.

Transfer of Credits from UIC

Transfer of credits earned at UIC to another institution is at the discretion of the accepting institution. It is the student's responsibility to confirm whether or not credits will be accepted by another institution of the student's choice.
