

ENTRANCE COUNSELING

To complete Entrance Counseling as an undergraduate student or graduate/professional student, you will need:

- 20-30 minutes to complete
- Your Federal Student Aid PIN

Students must log in using their own PIN to complete Entrance Counseling. **Use of another person's PIN constitutes fraud. Use only your own PIN information.**

• Name(s) of the school(s) you wish to notify of counseling completion

Useful Information to Have

Any details on your income, financial aid, and living expenses. Some of this information can be found in:

- Your student account information
- A copy of the award letter from your school's financial aid office (if you have received it)
- A listing of the tuition and fees for your school. Visit CollegeNavigator.gov

There are two ways to access Entrance Counseling:

- 1. Log in to StudentLoans.gov using your PIN
 - o Select "Complete Counseling" on the left-hand navigation bar
 - o Select "Entrance Counseling" under "Choose Counseling Type"

If you log in, you will be able to:

- See your federal student loan information available in the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS)
- Notify schools of counseling completion
- View proof of counseling completion
- Select "Getting Loans" from the top navigation bar on the StudentLoans.gov home page and then "Counseling Demo." Select "Entrance Counseling" under "Choose Counseling Type."
 - \circ You must log in to officially complete the counseling session (option 1 above)
 - The "Counseling Demo" option is informational and allows school administrators to see counseling content without logging in

Parents borrowing a Direct PLUS Loan to pay for their child's education are not required to complete entrance counseling.
