# Admissions

## General Admissions Requirements

1. Submit a completed and signed Application for Admission and be present for an entrance interview.
2. Each applicant must submit an official transcript showing a conferred Bachelor degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or an equivalent evaluated degree for international applicants.
3. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 on a 4.0 scale as reflected on undergraduate official transcripts. Official transcripts must be received by UIC directly from all previous educational institution.
4. Government issued ID
5. Two letters of recommendation from previous professors or employers.
6. Applicants whose native language is not English are required to provide proof of English language proficiency by submitting the minimum score on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Internet Based Test 78, TOEFL - Computer Based Test 173, Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) 69 or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) all levels score: 6.0. Students whose native language is not English but have completed at

least two years of study in an American high school or College are exempt from taking the proficiency test. Appropriate evidence must be provided

## International Students

General Admissions requirements 1-6 in addition to:

- Each applicant must submit an official evaluated transcript showing a conferred Bachelor degree Official evaluation of transcripts must be received by UIC directly from the International Credential Evaluator Institute. 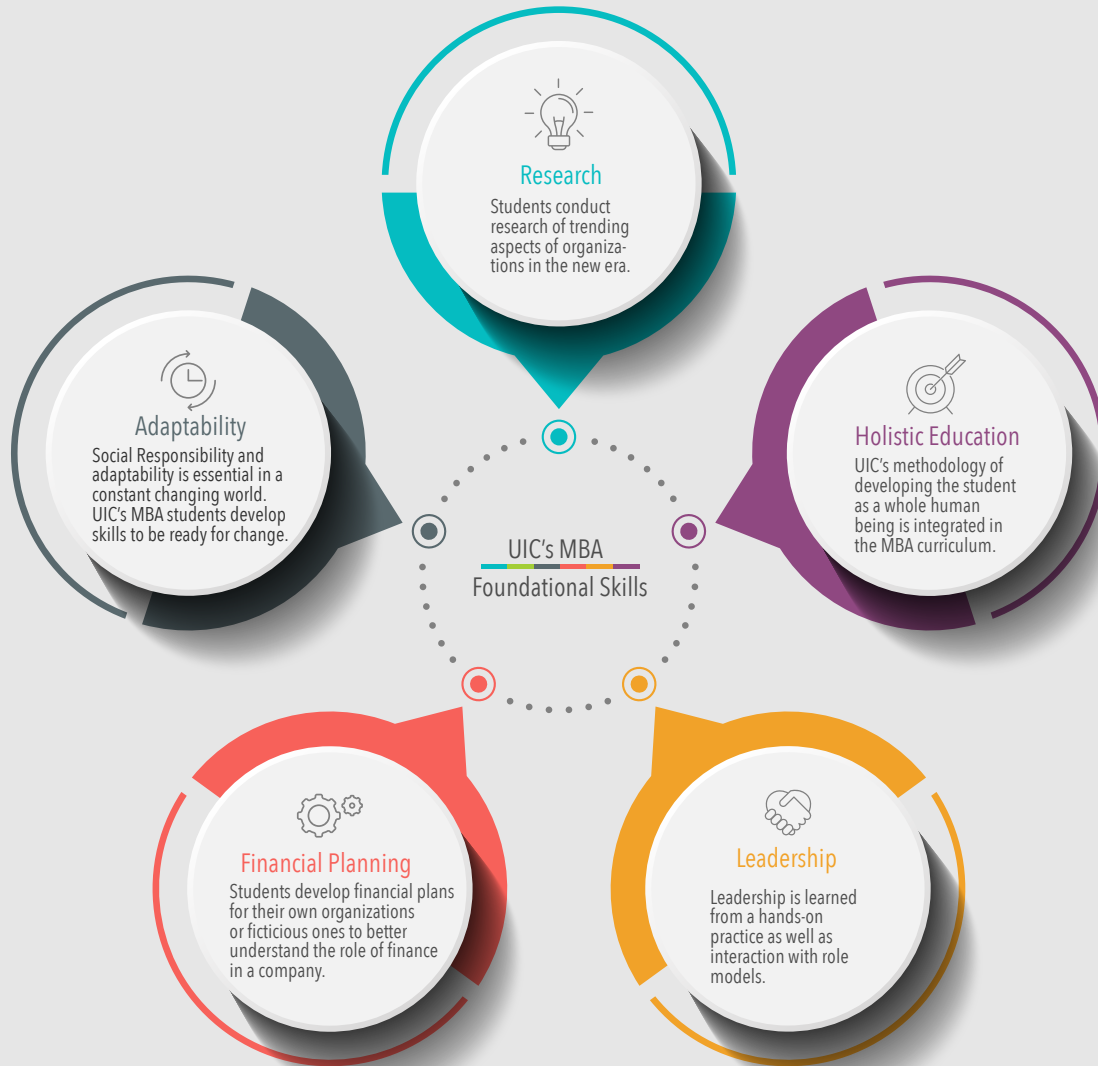
